March 4, 2010**

P. Byrnes called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. and introduced the Board.

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**Cazenovia Dental, Sign Variances (Freestanding, Area, Setback, and Second Sign),  
54 Nelson Street**

20 P. Byrnes opened the public hearing. He explained that the Board had received a request the  
previous day from Dr. Fauth to adjourn this meeting until he can have his counsel with him.

P. Byrnes further explained that it is the intention of this Board tonight to adjourn this meeting  
and set a date for the next meeting when Dr. Fauth and his counsel can be heard.

25 Members of the public were quite disconcerted that Dr. Fauth had canceled on such short notice  
and that no notice was given to the public.

P. Byrnes acknowledged receipt of a letter from Pringle Symonds. P. Byrnes gave Ms. Symonds  
the choice to read her letter tonight to enter it into the record or hold it until the Board convenes  
next time. Ms. Symonds opted to withdraw her letter for the time being.

30 P. Byrnes acknowledged receipt of the Madison County Planning Department's comments into  
the file.

35 Mr. Stokes noted for the record that this meeting is being adjourned at the specific request of the  
applicant. This was held open last month as well as Dr. Fauth was unable to attend that meeting.

A member of the public asked if there is a limit to the number of times an applicant can request  
adjournment. Mr. Stokes believes there is no limit as long as the applicant and the Board agree.

40 P. Byrnes noted that the next scheduled meeting is on March 23 at 7:00 p.m. and this hearing can  
be adjourned until that time and date.

P. Byrnes made the motion to adjourn Dr. Fauth's public hearing until March 23 at 7:00 p.m.  
H. Hart seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous and the motion carried.

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P. Byrnes stated that Dr. Fauth would be notified of the new date and time.

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P. Byrnes asked if anyone had any corrections to the December 15, 2009, minutes. No one did. P. Byrnes made the motion to accept the minutes as written. H. Hart seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

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P. Byrnes asked if anyone had any corrections to the January 26, 2010, minutes. No one had any. S. Ryan made the motion to approve the minutes as written. H. Hart seconded the motion. The motion unanimously passed.

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P. Byrnes made the motion to adjourn the meeting and W. Keiser seconded. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:21 p.m.
